Civic Service Stadium Renewal Project

The Civic Service Stadium Renewal Project is well underway and scheduled for completion in August. This \$2.6 Million Community Project was funded by the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund and FedNor as well as a private donation. The Town's contribution was \$150,000 and the Second Ice Surface Fund was used toward the ice surface.

This park will become a community hub for recreation of all kinds for the residents and families of Kirkland Lake. The ice surface will be available for family skating and hockey in the winter and will be lighted at night. It can be used for ball hockey, roller blades and beer garden for special events in the summer months. The park will contain 3 tennis courts which can be converted for multi-use basketball, volleyball and mini soccer courts, a sand volleyball court, walking path, band shell for concerts and entertainment and a baseball field. The centre of the park will be grassed area for concert seating or grass sports. The plan also contains a new concession building and washrooms.

The Town is pleased to enhance outdoor activities for the residents of Kirkland Lake with a goal to improve health, lifestyle and enjoyment for our residents and their families.
