

## The Corporation of the Town of Kirkland Lake

Bylaw 19-067

Being a Bylaw to Set the Municipal Water and Wastewater Rates for 2019

WHEREAS the Municipal Act 2001, S. O. 2001 c. 25, Section 391 provides for a municipality to impose fees or charges for the consumption of Water and discharge of Wastewater.

WHEREAS Section 290.(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, requires that the Municipality shall prepare and adopt a budget including estimates of all sums required during the year for municipal purposes.

AND WHEREAS public meetings were held on April 4, and July 9, 2019 for purpose of setting rates for water consumption and discharge of wastewater for 2019;

AND WHEREAS the Municipally managed Water Budget in the amount of \$2,526,498 was adopted by Bylaw 19-066 on July 16, 2019, as the Water Budget for the Corporation of the Town of Kirkland Lake for the year 2019.

AND WHEREAS the Municipally managed Wastewater Budget in the amount of \$1,713,105 was adopted by Bylaw 19-066 on July 16, 2019, as the Wastewater Budget for the Corporation of the Town of Kirkland Lake for the year 2019.

## NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND LAKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the several rates enumerated in Schedule 'A' attached hereto are hereby imposed and levied for:
  - a. water supplied to all water users from the waterworks system obtaining their supply from Gull Lake, and
  - b. discharge of wastewater for all users of the Kirkland Lake and Swastika Sewage Treatment Plants.
- 2. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on January 1, 2019.

Read a first, second and third time, enacted and passed this 16<sup>th</sup> day of July 2019.
