Message from Mayor and Council

We are pleased to present this financial summary of the Town's operations for 2017, as well as a summary of the 2018 budget. For taxpayers who are looking for more information, a copy of the 2017 Consolidated Financial Statements is available from the Treasury Division, Corporate Services located at Town Hall.

This year our net operating budget, including the water and waste water budget, is \$20,583,283. Keeping our operating budget along the line of inflation, allows the town to increase expenditures in our capital budget. Our total capital budget for 2018 is \$5,518,998. These capital expenditures are made possible due to the financial contributions of the provincial and federal governments, working capital and the general levy. Some of the projects that we will be undertaking are completion of the O'Meara Blvd reconstruction, repaving of part of Government Road, year four of a four year road work plan, finishing off the new aquatic centre, equipment replacement and upgrades as well as upgrading Municipal buildings to new accessibility standards.

This year Mayor and Council approved a 6% residential tax rate increase due to the need to fund critical capital projects from the tax levy.

We are continuing our aggressive approach towards tax collection, however when a taxpayer does not pay their taxes it has an impact on every other taxpayer in Kirkland Lake. If you are in arrears, contact our tax department and they will help you to develop a plan to assist in the repayment of your taxes.




