

Council Decisions – November 19, 2019

1. That Council adopted a report on Annual Repayment Limit for the corporation.
2. Council directed financing for the 2019 Capital Budget acquisition of a loader through infrastructure Ontario using a 10-year term.
3. Council endorsed a call by the Association of Municipalities of Ontario to review joint and several liability to provide additional protection for municipalities.
4. Council approved a temporary amendment to the hiring policy to allow for the hiring of immediate staffing needs – and that written deviations to the process will be documented.
5. Council received the final Planning report for the Pinetree Road and Sandy Drive area.
6. Council received and approved the updated Operational Plan for Kirkland Lake's Drinking Water System.
7. Council temporarily designates OCWA as the Overall Operating Authority for sewage collection.
8. Council approved the applications for funding for:
 - a. The Municipal Modernization Program for an in-depth service delivery review
 - b. The Connecting Link Funding Program to repave Government Road East (Burnside Drive to the eastern limits of Town)
9. Council passed bylaws to appoint Yves Labelle as the Interim CAO and delegate administrative powers to him.
10. Council passed to contract Nigel Bellchamber for the search and recruitment of a permanent Chief Administrative Officer.
11. Council passed a bylaw to appoint Hunter Hamelin to the Kirkland Lake Youth Council Committee.
12. Council passed a bylaw to authorize an agreement with Nigel Bellchamber for the search and recruitment of a permanent Chief Administrative Officer.
