1. Council received a presentation from Northern College.
2. Council received a delegation from Bernadine Cozac regarding her property at 26 Dixon.
3. Council received a verbal update on the COVID-19 Pandemic.
4. Council referred the Policy Manual back to staff to include documents of policies that are not on the list to be in force and effect.
5. Council deemed 4 Summerset Drive surplus and directed staff to enter into an agreement of purchase and sale with Marc Bronson for a sale price of \$2000.00.
6. Council referred the Request to Purchase Land – East of 26 Dixon to the first meeting of November to allow Ms. Cozac to provide any additional documents.
7. Council approved 2 CIP applications with the recommendations from the Economic Development Committee.
8. Council passed a by-law to execute documents of a Site Plan Control Agreement for 11 Station Road South.
9. Council passed a by-law to enter into an agreement with DST Consulting Engineers Inc. for the supply and installation of monitoring wells at the KL Landfill.
