1. Council received a delegation from MPP John Vanthof
2. Council appointed Tracy Barbe as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer
3. Council approved correspondence to be submitted to the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing from a consent application to note that the Town of Kirkland Lake opposes any new development in surrounding unorganized townships
4. Council awarded the Tender for Lakeshore Road and McCamus Avenue Resurfacing to Miller Paving Ltd.
5. Council approved any remaining budgeted funds from the Lakeshore/McCamus resurfacing project to resurface additional sections of asphalt roads within the municipality on a priority basis
6. Council accepted the Town of Kirkland Lake Drinking Water System Financial Plan
7. Council approved the donation of 200 Swim Passes to the Chamber of Commerce for their Halloween Scavenger Hunt
8. Council directed staff to apply for a grant from the Federation of Canadian Municipalities' Municipal Asset Management Program to advance the Town's Asset Management Program
9. Council passed a by-law to execute sale documents for property north of 4 Summerset Drive
10. Council passed a by-law to Deem the property north of 4 Summerset Drive to not be registered
11. Council approved future Council Meetings to resume in Council Chambers
12. Council approved a request from the Royal Canadian Legion to hang banners on Government Road for an additional 3 seasons
