- 1. Council received a delegation from MP Charlie Angus
- 2. Council received a delegation from Penny and Gary Fournel regarding an encroachment for property on Kirkland Ave in Swastika
- 3. Council received a verbal update on COVID-19
- 4. Council resolved that staff be directed to present an encroachment agreement for the Fournel property on Kirkland Ave in Swastika
- 5. Council approved documents to be executed for a land lease agreement at the Kirkland Lake Airport with Bill Durocher
- 6. Council declared Oct 19-25 as waste reduction week
- 7. Council resolved that staff be directed to contact user groups to gage interest in advertising in the Complex lobby and for staff to report back to Council before the end of 2020 on the stand alone kiosk option
- 8. Council accepted the recommendations from the Police Service Board to not allow the additional off-road vehicles permitted as of July 1, 2020 in the off-road vehicle by-law and directed staff to look into if Main Street warrants being a community safety zone
- 9. Council passed a Training, Education and Development policy
- 10. Council awarded the Kirkland Lake Water Treatment Plant PLC and SCADA replacement to Stroma Automation Solutions with OCWA to provide support services to facilitate the replacement project. Council authorized the reallocation of \$160,000.00 from the Energy Efficiency Capital Project to the SCADA upgrade in the 2020 approved Capital Budget with the residual amount carried forward as a 15 month project into the 2021 Capital budget and directed staff to include \$90,000.00 in the 2021 Capital Budget for SCADA upgrades as a pre-approved project.
