- 1. Council resolved to fill the vacant seat to the next highest receiver of votes from the 2018 Municipal Election Lad Shaba.
- 2. Council awarded RFQ-560-20 to Premier Recycling Timmins.
- 3. Council resolved to have staff be directed to present a by-law to execute an agreement with Call2Recycle Canada Inc. for the collection of used consumer-type portable batteries.
- 4. Council approved funds up to \$2000.00 to be allocated in the 2022 budget for the Central Ontario Ortho Photography Project.
- 5. Council approved updates to the Code of Conduct for Building Officials policy.
- 6. Council passed a by-law to sell property adjacent to 26 Dixon Ave.
- 7. Council received correspondence from MPP John Vanthof regarding Bill 226 -The Broadband is an Essential Service Act.
- 8. Council received correspondence from Solicitor General Sylvia Jones regarding The Town of Kirkland Lake's AMO delegation.
- 9. Council resolved to suspend Councillor Rick Owen's remuneration for a period of 30 days beginning November 18, 2020 as a penalty to a Code of Conduct contravention as outlined in an Integrity Commissioner investigation.
