- 1. Newly appointed Councillor Lad Shaba was sworn in by taking the Oath of Office.
- 2. Council received a presentation from WSCS for reporting on their Service Delivery Review and resolved to have the recommendations referred to staff to be included in to the Strategic Plan for 2021.
- 3. Council approved Team Northern Throttle's request to utilize the Goodfish snow dump to host 2 snow drag events and to utilize the Airport for 1 drag race event in 2021.
- 4. Council resolved to have staff be directed to submit correspondence to the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing in regard to consent application 54-C-201411.
- 5. Council resolved to have staff be directed to re-tender RFB-493-16 Construction Services for the Swastika Water Pollution Control Plant Decommissioning and Sewer System Connection to the Kirkland Lake Wastewater Treatment Plant after an engineering review.
- 6. Council resolved to retain the name of the Joe Mavrinac Community Complex and to have staff be directed to place \$20,000 for discussion in the 2021 Proposed Capital Budget for a new sign.
- 7. Council approved a Community Grants Policy.
- 8. Council approved a Flag, Banner and Announcement Protocol Policy.
- 9. Council approved amendments to the Signing Policy.
- 10. Council passed a motion of support for Bill 226 The Broadband is an Essential Service Act.
- 11. Council passed a by-law to execute documents relating to the sale of 3 McKelvie Ave. to Jerome Maritim.
- 12. Council passed a by-law to repeal by-laws enacting policies that are not needed to be passed by by-law.
- 13. Council passed a by-law to execute an agreement with Call2Recycle Canada Inc.
