

COUNCIL DECISIONS – MAY 5, 2020

1. Council approved the Food Market to open at its regular date of June 22nd with proper protocols in place from Farmers' Markets Ontario.
2. Council postponed the Material Hazardous Waste Event until September 5, 2020.
3. Council received a Service Delivery Review of Heritage North and directed staff to take the next steps to divest the Municipality of Heritage North but continue operating until a sale is concluded.
4. Council received the proposed 2020 Capital budget and will host a Special Meeting on May 12, 2020 to discuss the proposed capital budget further.
5. Council passed a false alarm bylaw that focuses on alarm system malfunctions to help reduce the number of false alarms KLFS responds to each year.
