

## **COUNCIL DECISIONS – JUNE 15 2021**

- Council received a delegation from TNT for final approval for their June drag race event. Council approved TNT to proceed with their scheduled event utilizing the TKL Airport June 23-28 following all COVID regulations and permitted a change in date for their August event if required.
- 2. Council received a delegation from Anna Boudreault and Francine Sanche with a proposal for making the park on the corner of Second Street and Station Road a Loose Parts Playground.
- 3. Council resolved to have staff be directed to work with the volunteers for the proposed Loose Parts Playground and create a use agreement to bring to Council for consideration.
- 4. Council received an update on what has been being implemented through the Age Friendly Grant and resolved to have staff be directed to continue implementing action items to ensure Kirkland Lake is an age-friendly community.
- 5. Council received and approved an Employee Wellness Strategy.
- 6. Council approved the revised Health and Safety Policy.
- 7. Council received a report on dispatch calls coordinating with the ONR for calls in Swastika.
- 8. Council declared lands in Pacaud Township known as Parcel 5104 SEC SST as surplus and resolved to have staff be directed to provide notice of intent to sell and present a bylaw to Council to enter into an agreement of purchase and sale.
- 9. Council waived the two-year moratorium for a Zoning Amendment application at 42 Second Street.
- 10. Council received a report on Integrity Commissioner financials from this term of Council.
- 11. Council resolved to have staff be directed to report on how many properties are being charged for commercial water in residential homes and how the Town might be able to offer any relief to these home businesses being shut down because of COVID.
- 12. Council passed a by-law to adopt the 2021 Municipal Budget
- 13. Council passed a by-law to set the tax ratios for municipal purposes for the year 2021.
- 14. Council passed a by-law to adopt the estimates of all sums required during the year and to strike the rates of taxation for the year 2021.
- 15. Council passed a by-law to set the municipal water and wastewater rates for 2021.
- 16. Council resolved to have Town Hall and Physical Services re-open to the public as of Monday, June 21, 2021 following all COVID protocols.
