1. Council held a Public Meeting for a proposed Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-Law Amendment for 40-42 Second Street
2. Council received a delegation from John MacDonell from the Legion for requesting work to be done to the parking lot
3. Council resolved to have staff be directed to obtain a formal proof of claim acceptance or denial from the Legion as well as contact the Town's insurance as a potential claim in order for an investigation into potential liability for the Legion parking lot
4. Council approved a request from KL Gold to use the Airport on August 13th for an employee drive in movie event
5. Council resolved to have staff be directed to complete a Phase 2 application of the Canada Community Revitalization Fund for Civic Park re-envisioning
6. Council resolved to have staff be directed to present an executing by-law to enter into an agreement with Piotrowski Consultants Ltd. for gathering information to be included into the Green and Inclusive Community Buildings Fund submission.

14. Council passed a by-law to sell lands on Park Street to Robert Portelance
15. Council passed a by-law to repeal by-laws that delegate authority and appoint a CAO
16. Council passed a by-law to authorize Mayor and Clerk to execute an agreement with Northland Group of Companies for arena refrigeration retrofit
