

## **COUNCIL DECISIONS – JANUARY 12, 2021**

- 1. Council received a verbal COVID-19 update.
- 2. Council resolved to have staff be directed to hold public consultations on the proposed harvesting of timber on municipally owned lands.
- 3. Council authorized the Ontario Federation of Snowmobile Clubs, Golden Corridor Snowdrifters, a land use permit over 5 mining claims south of Armer Lake.
- 4. Council resolved to have staff be directed to present an updated listing of strategic priorities that encompass deliverables from the Service Delivery Review.
- 5. Council received an update on a financial policies framework.
- 6. Council received an update on the 2021 Budget process.
- 7. Council adopted recommendations from the December 9, 2020 Police Services Board meeting and resolved to have staff be directed to review the trail from First Street to Station Road for possible solutions to assist with the complaint of increased theft in the area by utilizing that trail and for staff to send a letter to the MTO to review the section of Government Road West from Gold Thorpe Road to Archer Drive to reduce the speed limit.
- 8. Council received an update on the new accessibility requirements for website content and resolved to have staff be directed to look into third party costs for video closed captioning services.
- 9. Council passed a by-law to set the interim tax levy and penalty and interest rates of 1 percent per month.
- 10. Council passed a by-law to set the water and wastewater rates for 2021 prior to the adoption of the budget. Rates have been extended from 2020.
- 11. Council passed a by-law to authorize the borrowing for current expenditures for 2021.
- 12. Council passed a by-law to execute the collective agreement between TKL and CUPE Local 1074.
- 13. Council passed a by-law to execute an agreement with Ontario Federation of Snowmobile Clubs.
