## Council Decisions – June 7, 2022

- Council received a verbal report from the CAO on his attendance at the 2022 FONOM Conference
- Council approved the Timiskaming District Joint Compliance Audit Committee Terms of Reference and passed an adopting By-Law.
- Council approved changes to their Notice Policy By-Law and directed that the By-Law be presented on June 21, 2022.
- Council directed that a site inspection be conducted at Foss Lane and a further Report be prepared identifying options for remediation in the standard/design of Foss Lane.
- Council authorized the vesting of 20 Queen Street and 7 Park Street in the Town of Kirkland Lake and that the municipal taxes be written-off.
- Council approved a Disconnecting from Work Policy.
- Council adopted the Timiskaming District Community Safety and Well-Being Plan and approved in principle an annual contribution for a Community Safety and Well Being (CSWB) Plan resource based on the current apportionments by the District of Timiskaming Social Services Administration Board (DTSSAB), resulting in a districtwide funding approach.
- Council approved updates to the Property Standards By-Law and directed that the By-Law be presented on July 13, 2022.
- Council passed a By-Law appointing Ryan Barrette as Building Inspector and Property Standards Officer.
- Councillor Wight posed the question and Council directed that a report be prepared identifying the purpose, data collection and communication of results of the Town's Portable Traffic Radar Signs at the June 21, 2022 Regular Meeting of Council.
- Councillor Adams brought forth a notice of motion to reconsider the Flag, Pole & Banner Announcements Protocols Policy (CORP2020-026)
- Council approved the sale of land at 776 Government Road West in the amount of \$8,000.00, authorized the Mayor and Clerk to sign the necessary sale documents, and directed that the by-law for the sale of the property be presented on June 21, 2022.
- Council offered a lease for the north part of 31 Kirkland Street West, authorized the Mayor and Clerk to sign the necessary documents, and directed that execution by-law be presented on June 21, 2022.
- Council approved the sale of mining claims legally described as L16555, L16554, L15750, L15752, L16589, L11882, L16619 & L16691 and the South part of mining claims L1354 & MC6787 to Agnico-Eagle for the amount of \$818,913.00, authorized the Mayor and Clerk to sign the necessary sale documents, and directed that the by-law for the sale of the property be presented on June 21, 2022.
