

Council Decisions – February 15th, 2022

1. Council approved updates to the Signing Authority Policy.
2. Council approved a community grant application for Riverside Community Garden.
3. Council approved an allocation of \$25,000 in the 2022 Capital Budget for Community Grants.
4. Council received a COVID-19 Policy update.
5. Council received information regarding the 2022 Municipal Elections and their option to pass a by-law or submit a question to electors at the polls.
6. Council directed staff to maintain the existing statutory threshold (upon a tie vote only) for recounts in the 2022 Municipal Elections in accordance with the Municipal Elections Act.
7. Council approved the appointment of a Compliance Audit Committee for the 2022 Municipal Elections, directed staff to seek regional collaboration to form a joint committee, and authorized the advertisement for membership.
8. Council authorized the CAO to receive delegated authority for Restricted Acts as noted in the Municipal Act in the event of a 'Lame Duck Council' for Municipal Elections.
9. Councillor Shaba brought forward a notice of motion for the addition of a community playground in Chaput Hughes to be considered along with funding as part of the 2022 Capital budget deliberations, and requested that staff investigate a suitable parkland.
10. Council passed a by-law to execute a franchise agreement with Enbridge Gas Inc.
11. Council passed a by-law to execute a collective agreement with C.U.P.E Local 26.
12. Council passed a housekeeping by-law to execute a land sale agreement with Kirkland Lake Gold Ltd.
13. Council passed a by-law to execute a transfer agreement for Northern Ontario Resource Development Support (NORDS) funding.
14. Council passed a by-law to delegate administrative powers to the Chief Administrative Officer.
15. Council passed a by-law appointing a Chief Building Official and Property Standards Officer.
