

## *Council Decisions – March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022*

1. Council approved an update to the Signing Authority Policy adding the newly appointed Deputy Treasurer.
2. Council received the annual Summary of Remuneration and Expenses from Elected Officials for 2021.
3. Council received an update on the Museum of Northern History and directed that an investigation and a subsequent report be presented to Council, including the consultation with the Museum Advisory Committee, on the operational impacts of operating seasonally and other alternatives.
4. Council authorized the single/sole source purchase of services, materials and equipment for the Airport RATI Funding Project.
5. Council authorized the emergency repairs to the loader mounted snow blower and allocated the costs in repairs within the 2022 Capital Budget.
6. Council received and approved a Use of Corporate Resources for Municipal Elections Purposes Policy.
7. Council approved the attendance of the Chief Administrative Officer, Mayor Kiely, and Councillor Shaba at the 2022 Federation of Northern Ontario Municipalities (FONOM) Conference.
8. Council received and accepted the 2021 Annual/Summary Report for the Kirkland Lake Drinking Water System which will be posted on the Town's website and copy made available for public viewing at the Public Works Office on Dunfield Road.
9. Council ratified a Motion Requesting a Minister's Zoning Order with respect to the Boreal Medieval Forest Project.
10. Council passed a By-Law appointing a Deputy Treasurer for The Corporation of the Town of Kirkland Lake.
11. Council passed a By-Law adopting the Use of Corporate Resources for Election Purposes Policy.
12. Council authorized the purchase of network hardware funded from the Town's Organization Restructuring and Efficiency Reserve and allocated the within the Management Information Systems' 2022 Operating Budget.
13. Council approved the sale of land described as 0.11 acres of land adjacent to 195 Pollock Avenue to Community Living Kirkland Lake, directed the execution of the Offer to Purchase, and directed that the by-law for the sale of the property be presented on April 5, 2021.
