1. Council approved the sale of land described as Lots 74 & 75, M112 - 0 Folger Street, and directed the execution of the Offer to Purchase.
2. Council authorized the application for a Stage One Infrastructure Expansion Funding submission to NOHFC/FedNor in support of extending services to CHAR Technologies' proposed High Temperature Pyrolysis facility in the Archer Drive Industrial Park.
3. Council approved a 2022 Frog's Breath Foundation application by the Golden Corridor Snow Drifters with a \$7,000.00 grant to purchase a special pump for flooding water crossings and to build a trail detour to re-establish a connection to the Province of Québec.
4. Council approved the Guidelines and amended the meeting Schedule for the Town of Kirkland Lake's 2022 Operating and Capital Budget.
