- Council received a Fire Services and Apparatus update and directed the CAO to identify replacement options of the aerial ladder truck.
- Council received an update on Town of Kirkland Lake Solar Inc.
- Council approved a Business Case Study for the establishment of a Municipal Services Corporation and directed the CAO to retain an external professional advisory firm to establish and organize a Municipal Services Corporation.
- Council approved an Asset Transfers to Corporations Policy.
- Council received information and denied the application request from Northern College for municipal parking enforcement services on private property.
- Council directed the Treasurer to complete year-end transfers relating to the 2022 Reserve and Reserve Funds.
- Council enacted a by-law establishing the remuneration for members of Council of the Town of Kirkland Lake for their Term of Office.
- Mayor Wight declared the month of January 2023 as 'Alzheimer's Awareness Month'; a flag raising at Town Hall will occur on January 5, 2023 with representatives from the Cochrane-Temiskaming Alzheimer's Society.
- Councillor Ranger and Councillor Kiely were appointed to the Temiskaming Provincial Offences Act Advisory Committee.
- Council made subsequent appointments to their Planning Advisory Committee and Committee of Adjustment and directed the Municipal Clerk to conduct a month-long call for volunteer interest for the following Committees: Museum Advisory (4 vacancies); Economic Development Committee (5 vacancies), Planning Advisory Committee (1 vacancy); Property Standards Committee (1 vacancy); Community Standards Committee (1 vacancy).
