

Council Decisions– February 21, 2023

- Council received a delegation from the Kenogami Watershed Ecological Alliance (KWEA).
- Council received a delegation from Agnico Eagle Mines Ltd.
- Council cancelled Lease/Encroachment Agreements for 23 Premier Avenue West and 60 Second Street.
- Councillor Kiely withdrew his Notice of Motion re: Ukraine Request for Donations.
- Council resolved to support the request from the Centre santé communautaire du Temiskaming for equitable access to phlebotomy (blood) services in the north-end of the District of Timiskaming.
- Council resolved to support the passing of Bill 42- Gender Affirming Health Care Act.
- Council authorized an execution agreement for Professional Building & Safety Services with RSM Building Consultants Inc.
- Council approved the sale of lands described as Parts 1 & 2, 54R-6325 (vacant land adjacent to 1 Foss Lane) to Rene Emmell in the sum of \$2,082.81.
- Council approved the Memorandum of Settlement between The Corporation of The Town of Kirkland Lake and United Steelworkers Local 2020 (Volunteer Fire Fighters) covering the period of February 3, 2023 to February 3, 2026. Council also authorized the signing of the Collective Agreement between the Town of Kirkland Lake and the United Steelworkers Local 2020 to be brought forward on March 7, 2023.
- Council made the following appointments to Committees of Council:
 - Kirkland Lake Economic Development Committee – Natasha Dombrowski; and
 - Kirkland Lake Museum Advisory Committee – Melinda Robin.
