

Council Decisions - March 7, 2023

The following is a summary of actions and decisions from Council at its Regular Meeting held March 7, 2023. A recording of the meeting can be viewed on the Town's YouTube channel. - Council received a delegation from FoodCycle Science Municipal Food Waste Diversion Program and directed Administration to prepare an information report surrounding the recommended Pilot Program.
- Council received a public report surrounding the Request to Purchase the Closed Road Allowances Adjacent to 1 Foss Road.
- Council received information and passed an execution by-law authorizing the execution of a Facility Use Agreement with Team Northern Throttle for the use of the Kirkland Lake Airport to host their Drag Race events inclusively from June 21st to June 26th and August 16th to August 21st, 2023.
- Council approved Community Improvement Plan (CIP) funding to 50 Government Road West for 50% eligible costs for façade (\$5,000 maximum) & building renovations/improvements (\$5,000 maximum).
- Council approved funding in the sum of \$5,000.00 from the Community Grant Program in support of the Lion's Club District A-5 Convention and Parade.
- Council authorized the execution of a two-year Extension Agreement with Green for Life Environmental (G.F.L) for weekly curbside collection of residential, commercial and institutional waste, and bi-weekly curbside collection of residential recycling and landfill operations as set out in RPP 503-18 for a total cost of \$2,127,562.82 plus HST; and that annual fuel costs adjustments be amended from the original agreement to be undertaken quarterly for the extended term.
- Councillor Shaba brought Notice of Motion to be considered at the March 21, 2023 meeting seeking a letter of support for the Kenogami Watershed Ecological Alliance (KWEA).
- Mayor Wight brought Notice of Motion to be considered at the March 21, 2023 meeting seeking support for the ESCEN Bursary Request.
- Council passed an execution by-law authorizing the execution of a Memorandum of Agreement with the Timiskaming Health Unit for the Performance of Work described in Section 7.0 Statement of Work identified in the District-wide Community Safety and Well-Being Plan (CSWBP).
- Council passed an execution by-law authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to execute all documents related to the sale of Parts 1 & 2, 54R-6325 (vacant land adjacent to 1 Foss Lane) to Rene Emmell.
