

Council Decisions– March 21, 2023

- Council cancelled land sales at 3 McKelvie Ave. and Lots 74 and 75, M112 Folger St. and repealed the respective authorizing by-laws.
- Council authorized Four Early Access Agreements and all easement documents with Hydro One Networks Inc. (HONI) and their execution (by by-law) in relation to the K4 Transmission Line.
- Council received the Town of Kirkland Lake [10-Year Road Reconstruction Plan](#).
- Council approved amendments and authorized the endorsement of the [Kirkland Lake Drinking Water System Operational Plan](#).
- Council approved the issuance of a Parade Permit to the Holy Name of Jesus Parish for the Way of the Cross. The Parade is scheduled for Friday, April 7, 2023 beginning at 11:00 AM at 39 Kirkland St. (Holy Name of Jesus Parish) and ending at 50 Kirkpatrick St.(Assumption Church).

- Council resolved to seek an information report investigating the viability of an annual Bursary Program to be distributed equally to both local secondary schools; that a policy be drafted and presented for implementation in 2023; and the sum of up to \$1,000.00 be approved in principle for 2023 and future years upon policy approval.
- Council passed a by-law appointing Courtney Nylund as the Deputy Chief Building Official and Property Standards Officer for The Corporation of The Town of Kirkland Lake.
- Council passed a by-law authorizing the Mayor and Municipal Clerk to sign the form of Endorsement on behalf of Council regarding amendments made to the Kirkland Lake Drinking Water System Operational Plan.
- Upon request from Councillor Shaba, Council received a status update on the proposed Chaput Hughes Playground Project from the Chief Administrative Officer.
- Upon request from Councillor Shaba, Council received information surrounding the Town and the Multicultural Group relationship (Assistance and Liaison).
- Councillor Kiely brought Notice of Motion to be considered at the April 4, 2023 meeting related to a Call to Action on Affordable Housing & Homelessness as supported by AMO.
