April 3, 2023

April 4, 2023

- Council authorized the renewal of the Municipal Fire Agreement with the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (MNRF) for an additional 5 years and authorized the execution of all related documents (by by-law).
- Council resolved to support the Town of Petrolia requesting changes to Ontario School Board Elections.
- Council resolved to support a Call to Action on Affordable Housing and Homelessness as supported by the Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO).
- Council resolved to support the Municipality of Trent Lakes requesting changes to the municipal Oath of Office.
- Mayor Wight brought Notice of Motion to be considered at the April 18, 2023 meeting related to Barriers for Women in Politics
- Mayor Wight brought Notice of Motion to be considered at the April 18, 2023 meeting related to Enbridge Gas Utility Field Locate Fee
- Mayor Wight brought Notice of Motion to be considered at the April 18, 2023 meeting related to the Reinstatement of Legislation permitting a municipality to retain surplus proceeds from Tax Sales.
- Mayor Wight brought Notice of Motion to be considered at the April 18, 2023 meeting related Northern College Skills Development Funding.
- Council approved the updated Memorandum of Settlement between The Corporation
 of The Town of Kirkland Lake and United Steelworkers Local 2020 (Volunteer Fire
 Fighters) covering the period of February 3, 2023 to February 3, 2026. Council also
 authorized the signing of the Collective Agreement between the Town of Kirkland Lake
 and the United Steelworkers Local 2020 to be brought forward on April 18, 2023.
