

Council Decisions – September 5, 2023

- Council authorized (by by-law) the execution of a Contribution Agreement with the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation (NOHFC) for funding up to \$457,337.00 under the Community Enhancement Program for the service expansion of Archer Drive Industrial Park.
- Council deemed (by by-law) Lots 32 and 33 of Registered Plan M-135T not to be Registered on a Plan of Subdivision (76 & 80 Federal Street).
- Council deemed (by by-law) Lots 10 and 11 of Registered Plan 4M-346 not to be Registered on a Plan of Subdivision (29 Harvey Drive).
- Council entered into a Lease Agreement (by by-law) for a portion of the municipal parking lot (25 parking spaces) located at Water Lane for exclusive use by tenants at 50 Government Road West.
- Council awarded (by by-law) an Elevator Modernization Upgrade at Town Hall to TK Elevator (Canada) Limited in the sum of \$133,585.00 + HST.
- Council entered into an Encroachment Agreement (by by-law) with Reginald Newton for parking on municipally owned property in Chaput Hughes (Part Mining Claim 2644).
- Council authorized (by by-law) the sale of land for Part of 69 and Part of 73 Brant Street (Comba).
- Council approved the transfer of \$10,000.00 from the Community Improvement Plan Reserve to the Community Grants Program for anticipated applications for financial assistance in 2023.
- Council approved to disburse the sum of \$5,000.00 to the Kirkland Lake Goldminers Junior A Hockey Club in response to their application under the Community Grants Program to help offset operating costs associated with the use of municipal facilities during the 2023-2024 season.
- Council approved to disburse the sum of \$1,464.00 to the Kirkland Lake District Chamber of Commerce in response to their application under the Community Grants Program to help offset costs associated with the 2023 Santa Claus Parade.
- Council approved to disburse the sum of \$5,000.00 to Kirkland Curling Ltd. In response to their application under the Community Improvement Plan to help offset the costs associated in replacing key components of the ice making plant at 44 Water Lane.
- Council approved to fund the sum of \$99,441.75 from the 2023 Lifecycle Replacement Fund for Accessible Parking and Paving at the Joe Mavrinac Community Complex.
- Council allocated the sum of \$43,918.00 from the 2023 Parkland Reserve Fund for the Chaput Hughes Playground Project.
- Council resolved for the preparation and issuance of an RFP for a feasibility study, conceptual designs and cost estimates for a Fire Hall site location; authorized \$60,000.00 from the Working Capital Reserve Fund for consultancy services and requested that the findings be presented to Council by the end of Q1 2024.
- Council received the Interim Financial Report Year-To-Date as at June 30, 2023 for information.
- Councillor Shaba brought notice of a Motion regarding Low-Speed Vehicles (LSV) Pilot Program for September 19, 2023.
