

## **Council Decisions – September 19, 2023**

• Council hosted a Public Meeting and received comments from the community surrounding proposed remediation: 4-Way Stop at Queen Street & Woods Street & Proposed Sidewalk Reinstatement on Woods Street.

• Council awarded a contract to Miller Paving Limited subject to the Terms set out in 598-23-RFT and modified scope of work as presented in the sum of \$674,150.00 plus HST for the 2023 Paving Program.
