

## **Council Decisions – October 3, 2023**

- Council authorized (by by-law) the borrowing for 2023 current expenditures.
- Council approved the reinstatement of the concrete sidewalk on the South West corner of the intersection at Queen and Woods Streets. Table B and Schedule B-3 of the Town's Traffic and Parking By-Law were amended (by <u>by-law</u>) to reflect the new 4-way stop at this intersection.
- Councillor Owen withdrew his Notice of Motion on Hazardous Waste.
- Council authorized (by <u>by-law</u>) the execution of the Collective Agreement between The Corporation of the Town of Kirkland Lake and CUPE Local 1074.
- Council authorized (by <u>by-law</u>) the execution of a Service Agreement with Miller Paving Limited for 2023 Asphalt Paving Services.
- Mayor Wight brought notice of a Motion regarding Northern Ontario School of Medicine University (NOSM U) Support to be considered by Council on October 17, 2023.
- Council approved the sale of land described as Lot 165 of Plan M158T, Swastika to Tyler Letellier in the sum of \$3,500.00.
- Council appointed Sheila Ackbarali to the Kirkland Lake Economic Development Advisory Committee.
