

Council Decisions – October 17, 2023

The following is a summary of actions and decisions from Council at its Regular Meeting held <u>October 17, 2023</u>. A recording of the meetings can be viewed on the <u>Town's YouTube channel</u>. - Council approved the Terms of Reference for the Economic Development and Tourism Strategic Plan and directed the preparation of a Request for Proposal (RFP) to retain a consultancy firm to complete the Plan.

- Council received a Revised Town of Kirkland Lake 10-Year Road Reconstruction Plan.

- Council received information surrounding the legislative reform and the impacts to the local Police Services Board; acknowledged their composition on the future board and authorized a Third Amending Agreement for the provision of Police Services under Section 10 of the *Police Services Act* expiring on December 31, 2024 or upon the regulations under the new *Community Safety Policing Act* taking effect.

- Council approved the updated <u>Terms of Reference</u> for the Teck Pioneer Residence Committee of Management.
- Council approved a Parade Permit for the Kirkland Lake District Chamber of Commerce to hold their annual Santa Claus Parade on Saturday November 25, 2023.
- Council approved their 2024 Council & Committee of Council Regular Meeting Schedules.
- Council supported the Northern Ontario School of Medicine University (NOSM U) in seeking a permanent increase in annual based funding of \$4,000.000.00 by year's end to sufficiently accommodate growth and expansion in response to the needs of Northern municipalities.
- Councillor Shaba brought notice of a Motion regarding Kirkland Lake Drive Center Hours of Operation to be considered by Council on November 7, 2023.
- Councillor Owen brought notice of a Motion regarding Traffic Calming to be considered by Council on November 7, 2023.
- Council directed that a report containing amendments to Council's Procedural By-Law be presented by year's end.
