

## Council Decisions - December 5, 2023

The following is a summary of actions and decisions from Council at its Regular Meeting held <u>December 5, 2023</u>. A recording of the meetings can be viewed on the <u>Town's YouTube channel</u>.  Council received information on public transit options and deferred direction until the passage of the 2023-2026 Town of Kirkland Lake Corporate Strategic Plan.

- Council established their annual remuneration and requested the development of a Council Renumeration Policy and a 1% increase be presented as part of the 2024 Budget.
- Council adopted updates to the <u>Winter Maintenance Manual</u>.

**Note:** the service level change in the deployment of the winter maintenance crew at 5 cms (previously 8cms).

- Mayor Wight brought the following Notices of Motions:
  - o Amendments to the Legislation Act,
  - Guaranteed Livable Income,
  - o Town Participation in Santa Clause Parade; and
  - Fixing Long-Term Care Amendment Act.
- Councillor Dikens brought notice of a Motion regarding Opposition to Strong Mayor Powers to be considered on December 19, 2023.
- The Mayor gave notice that on Wednesday, December 6<sup>th</sup>, flags at Town-managed facilities will be placed at half-mast position in observance of the National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence Against Women.
- Council authorized the purchase of a new back-up generator and the retention of professional services related to network infrastructure maintenance in the sum of \$25,000.00 to be drawn from the Town's Working Capital Reserve.
