

Council Decisions – January 24, 2024

The following is a summary of actions and decisions from Council at its Regular Meeting held <u>January 24, 2024</u>. A recording of the meetings can be viewed on the <u>Town's YouTube channel</u>. - Council approved all minutes in relation to their regular meeting on January 9[,] 2024, and those as presented by Committees of Council, and regional/local Boards.
- Council approved (by <u>by-law</u>) the Town to enter into a Temporary Services Agreement for integrity commissioner services and appointed M. Harold G. Elston as Interim Integrity Commissioner. The Request for Proposal (<u>608-24-RFP</u>) closes on February 15th at 2 PM.
- Council authorized (by by-law) annual borrowing for current expenditures.
- Council approved an **increase** to **Water rates by 1.7%** and **Wastewater rates** by **3.5%** for 2024; the establishing By-Law to be presented to Council at their February 6, 2024 meeting.
- Council approved updates to the Non-Union Employees' Benefits Policy, and approved a Non-Union Employees Vested Sick Leave Policy. The <u>Policies</u> can be viewed on the Town's Website.
- Council resolved to lobby the senior levels of government in **supporting** the **establishment** of a national **Guaranteed Livable Income Program**.
- Council requested an information report to investigate the feasibility of developing Part of Mining Claims 1829, L2103, TC709 and TC710, Parcels 6808, 7599 and 8670CST (currently serving as a parking lot) for multi-unit residences in the downtown core. See mapping for location proximity.
- Council authorized (by <u>by-law</u>) the execution of the **2023-2024 Transfer Payment Agreement** with the Ministry of Solicitor General for funding under the **Mobile Crisis Response Team Enhancement Grant**.
- Council passed a <u>by-law</u> to provide for the annual Interim Tax Levy, to provide for the payment of taxes, and to provide for penalty and interest (1.25%).
- Council declared Part Mining Claims L1355 & L6730 as surplus and authorized the sale of lands to CHAR Technologies in the sum of \$111,592.00.
