

Council Decisions - February 20, 2024

The following is a summary of actions and decisions from Council at its <u>Public</u> & <u>Regular</u> Meetings held February 20, 2024. - Council hosted a Public Meeting on the proposed 2024 Water and Wastewater Rates. The by-law will be considered for passage on March 5, 2024.
- Council approved all minutes in relation to their regular meeting on February 6, 2024, and those as presented by Committees of Council, and regional/local Boards.
- Council received a <u>presentation</u> from representatives from the Ontario Clean Water Agency (OCWA) noting 2023 Highlights and 2024 Plan.
- Council received the Town's <u>2023 Annual Accessibility Report</u>. The Town welcomes any <u>feedback</u> from the public in relation to this Report, or accessibility in general.
- Council authorized the execution of a <u>Facility Use Agreement</u> with Team Northern Throttle For Family Events for the use of the Kirkland Lake Airport to host their annual Summer Drag Race events inclusively from June 21-23, 2024 and July 12-14, 2024. The execution by-law will be considered for passage on March 5, 2024.
- Council received <u>supplemental information</u> on the Police Services Board Reform taking effect April 1, 2024; appointed Mayor Stacy Wight and Councillor Janice Ranger to the new Police Detachment Board and Working Group; jointly supported \$8,500.00 total remuneration of the KLDPSB's annual membership; directed \$1,750.00 be budgeted in 2024 for the Town's estimated share of remuneration, and \$10,000.00 for the Town's estimated share of the new Board's operating/capital costs.
- Council resolved to support the <u>Association of Ontario Roads Supervisors' Request</u> to develop a Municipal Equipment Operators Course to be fully funded by the Skills Development Fund.
- Council resolved to support Northern College in requesting that the <u>Provincial/Federal</u> Government reconsider its recent policy changes, to implement the Blue-Ribbon Panel recommendations, and actively work together to restore the eligibility of public-private partner colleges (institutions) to grant students who successfully complete their program of study a Post-Graduate Work Permit.
- Council resolved to support the <u>Township of Clearview's Resolution</u> regarding Cemetery Transfer/Abandonment Administration & Management Support.
- Council resolved to support the <u>Township of Evanturel's Resolution</u> regarding Social and Economic Prosperity Review.
- Council resolved to support the <u>Municipality of Tweed's Resolution</u> regarding One-Third (1/3) Funding Grant Programs.
- Councillor Casey Owens brought the following Notices of Motion to be considered on March 5, 2023:
 - Investigate Installation of Water Meters on New Construction (Builds) in the Town of Kirkland Lake; and
 - Regulation and Education on Lawn Watering.
